Question Responses & Comments

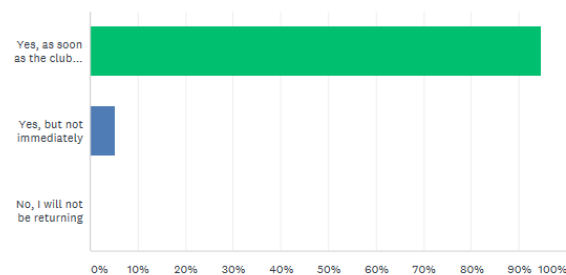
From the recent survey we had 76 respondents

Answered: 76 Skipped: 0



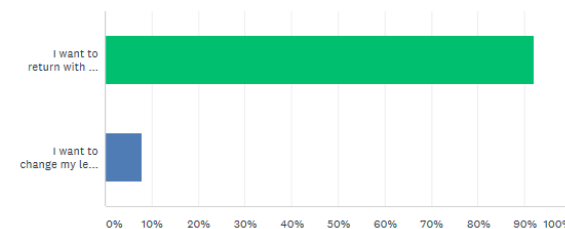

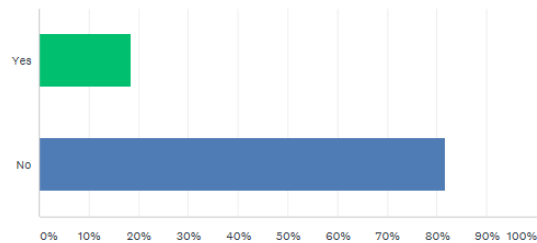
Comments received included the below:

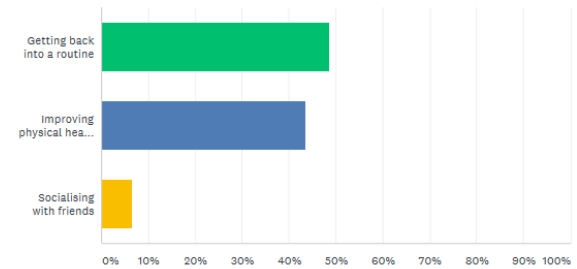

- Changing facilities, transmission of virus, ensuring working with facilities to supervise changing areas if used.
- I want reassurance that all swimmers are kept safe and that necessary changes are implemented. Safety is my priority.
- My main concern would be what will happen in the changing rooms with regards to cleanliness & hygiene, obviously the leisure centres will have their own risk assessments in place with maintaining high levels of hygiene, preventing the risk of spreading the virus but as a parent I would like to be able to go into the changing room areas to make sure she isn't touching areas unnecessarily, making sure she is quick resulting in her less likely to pick up the virus. Children are not going to be as vigilant & aware of their surroundings that could potentially pose a risk, so as an adult overlooking what she is doing would make me feel a lot more comfortable.
- Concerned that the amount of water time severely decreased. I expect some.
- That there will be only very limited opportunity for pool/coaching time.

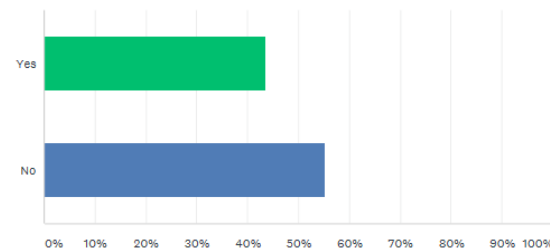

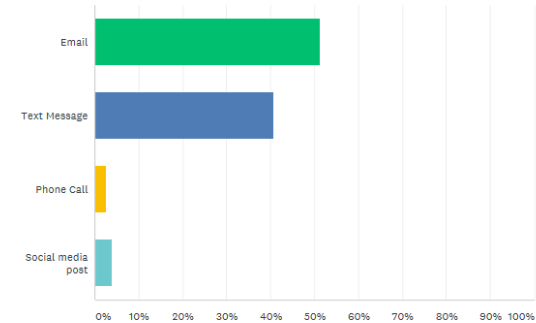

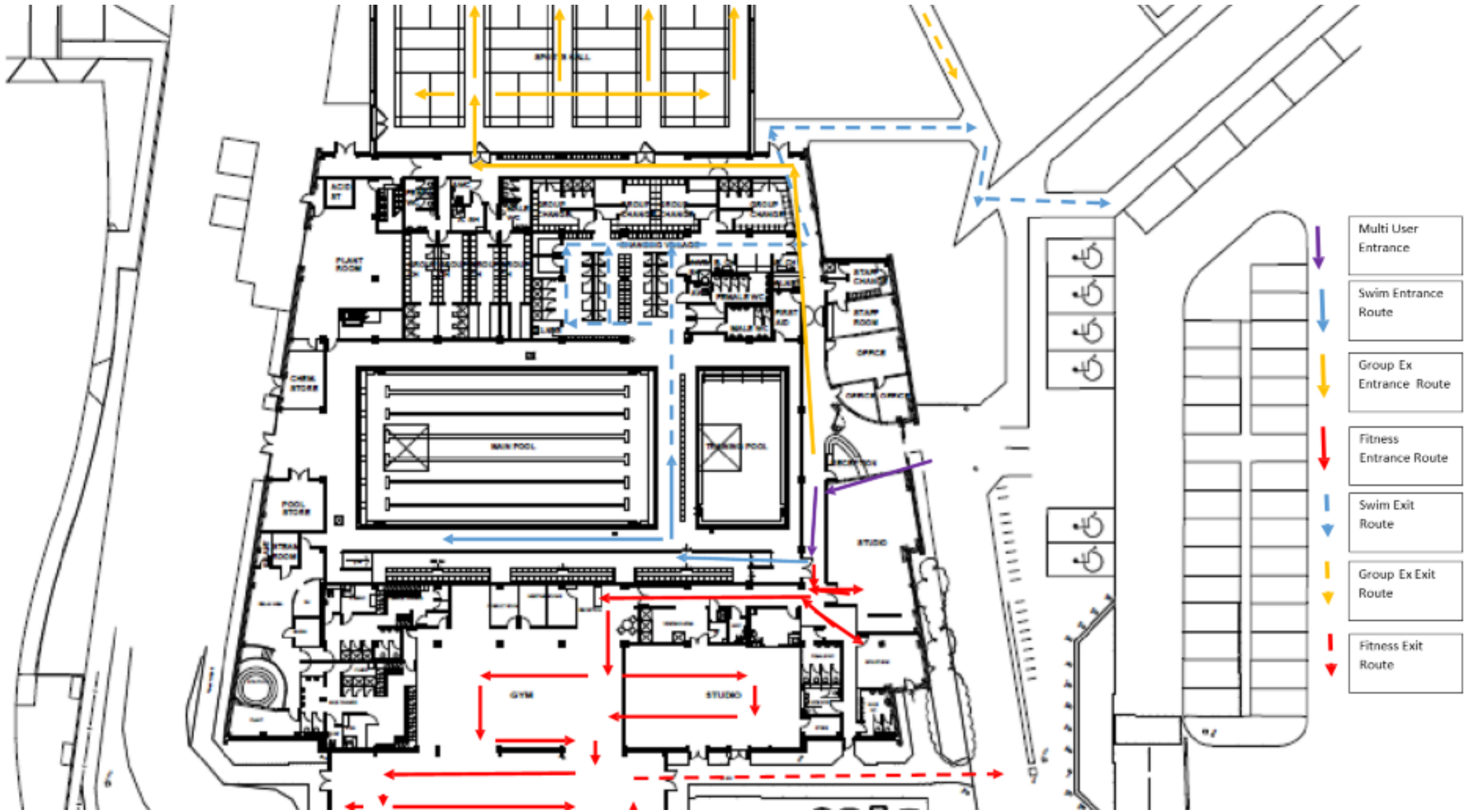
